General Rules & Regulations

1. All exhibitors may be residents of Iowa County or a surrounding county.
2. All exhibits will be placed in Zentmire Hall.
3. All exhibitors must be checked in Monday, July 12 from 6-8 p.m. and Tuesday, July 13 between 8-10 a.m. All exhibits will be judged on Tuesday.
4. Open House will be held Wednesday, July 14, 4-9 pm and Thursday, July 15th through Sunday, July 18 from 9 a.m. – 8 p.m.
5. Blue or red ribbons will be awarded to all entries. Blue Award of Excellence ribbons will be given to all outstanding entries, out of which, one exhibit in each department will be chosen "Best of Show," and will receive a purple "Best of Show" ribbon.
6. All entry fee money and proceeds from the bake sale will be used for Open Class Awards. Each "Best of Show" winner will receive an award.
7. All exhibits MUST be picked up on Sunday, July 18 from 12 Noon – 2 pm. Entries must be checked out with an Open Class Attendant before removing.
8. Entry Fee Is \$1.00 Per Item in all departments
9. Entries in ALL classes must be no older than TWO YEARS
10. Each exhibitor may enter as many items per class as they like.

Department 1 - Arts and Crafts

All pictures/art must be ready for hanging.

Department 2 - Photography

There is no limit as to the number of entries per class each exhibitor may enter. All photos are to be mounted. Exhibitors may mount their own photos on mat board, use ready-cut window mats, or have matting done professionally. Foam board may be added for stability. Framed photos will not be judged.

Department 3 - Professional Photography

There is no limit as to the number of entries per class each exhibitor may enter. All photos are to be mounted. Department 4 – Hobbies

A collection of (3 or more) small articles.

Example: marbles, pencils, pens, compacts, buttons, etc.)

Department 5 – Heritage

Articles made by an ancestor.

Example: clothing, quilts, small piece of furniture, toys, dolls, etc.

Department 6 - Textiles

All clothing must be brought on hangers. Exhibits may be brought in plastic bags to prevent soiling.

Embroidery, Latch Hook, Needlepoint

Department 7 - Quilts

Exhibits may be brought in plastic bags to prevent soiling. All items must be quilted. Piecing and quilting may be done by two different individuals.

Department 8 - Fruits and Vegetables

Each exhibitor may enter one (1) specimen per class. Entries must be grown by exhibitor. All vegetable and fruit specimens must be placed on a paper plate. Exhibitors are strongly encouraged to include the variety with their entry, as this is helpful to the judge, although it is not a requirement for entry.

Department 9 - Flowers

Entries must be grown by the exhibitor. Professional florists may not compete. Containers must be clear glass (e.g. pop bottle, glass milk bottle, fruit juice bottle, etc.) Include variety or name on entry tags. Note the number of stems requirement. ALL pollen anthers need to be removed, particularly from lilies.

Department 11 - Products of the Kitchen

All entries must be homemade by exhibitor. Cakes should be unfrosted with the exception of Decorated Cakes. Decorated Cakes may use box mixes. No custard or cream pies will be accepted. All exhibits are to be placed on a paper plate and put in a plastic bag. Pies should be in a disposable pie tin. A complete recipe on a 3x5" card must accompany each entry except for Decorated Cakes.

I. Yeast Bread and Rolls --- 6 rolls on a plate

All Other Bread Type Entries: Frozen, Mixes, Bread Machine

Canned Goods - Exhibit must include (2) jars. One will be opened by the judge for tasting; the other jar will be for display.

All jams, jellies, preserves, etc. **MUST BE PROCESSED**

IN HOT WATER BATH with two piece lid according to

Extension guidelines. Use of paraffin wax is **NOT** acceptable.

Recipes must be attached to entry. May enter (2) different items.
